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Reference for the Citizenship, North American Industry Classification System, and the Standard Occupation Classification codes

This reference is for completing the 2025 W-2CM entry box C, employee's citizen of country, box D, employer's North America Industry Classification System (NAICS), and box E, employee's Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) system.

Example 1 (for box C): Mr. A was recruited from the Philippines as a guest worker to work for ABC company. Since Mr. A is a citizen of the Philippines, his citizenship code is RP, as found in the Foreign Country Code Listings in this publication. Enter the appropriate code in box C of 2025 Form W-2CM.

Example 2 (NAICS): The employer, ABC company, is engaged in the construction business. To find the correct NAICS code, log in the NAICS website at <https://www.census.gov/naics/>. Use business key word(s) such as "construction" in the 2022 NAICS search box. When the search is completed, it will display a list of business industry codes related to construction. Select the most appropriate 6-digit code that describes your business and enter it in box D of 2025 Form W-2CM.

Example 3 (SOC): ABC company hired Mr. A, whose occupation is carpenter. To find the correct occupation code for Mr. A, log on to the O-NET website at <https://www.onetonline.org>. Use a keyword such as "carpenter" in the keyword search box. When the search is completed, it

will display a list of various occupations related to carpenters. Select the most appropriate 8-digit code that describes the type of carpentry work for Mr. A, and enter it in box E of 2025 Form W-2CM.

Introduction to NAICS

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) is the standard used by Federal statistical agencies in classifying business establishments for the purpose of collecting, analyzing, and publishing statistical data related U.S. business economy.

NAICS was developed under the auspices of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), and adopted in 1997 to the [Standard Industrial Classification \(SIC\) system](#). It was developed jointly by the [U.S. Economic Classification Policy Committee \(ECPC\)](#), [Statistics Canada](#), and Mexico's [Instituto Nacional de Estadística y Geografía](#), to allow for a level of comparability in business statistics among the North American countries.

This official U.S. Government Web site provides the latest information on plans for NAICS revisions, as well as access to various NAICS reference files and tools. Additional information on the background and development of NAICS is available in the [History](#) section of this Web site.
